




## HEALTH & ECOLOGY


## HISTORY, CULTURE & TOURS

"The Death of Adam (and Eve) : The Great Evolution Debate" by Dr. Michael Shortland

Or. Shortlend (University of Oxford) is currently a Visiting Professor at the Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, III, Madras. He has written extensively on the history and philosophy of sciences. His most recent works include Medicine and Film (1989) and, as co-editor, Let Newton Be (1988) and Teaching the History of Science (1989).



Dr. Shortland's talk will focus on a famous episode in the history of science, which occurred in Oxford in 1860 when Bishop Wiberforce debated with Professor Huxley the new-fangled idea of evolution. Religion versus Science?. Superstition versus Reason?

Dr. Shortland's illustrated talk will (with some surprising results!) throw light on that debate and, appropriately to the forum, will also touch on Victorian attitudes to women.




### ART & HANDICRAFTS




