

FROM THE TREASURERS

WARM GREETINGS TO ALL IWA MEMBERS! We are looking forward to your cooperation and active participation to make this year too a successful one.





MILLENNIUM WOMEN - FLORENCE ARTHAUD WHO MADE SAILING HISTORY

It was the evening of 18th November, 1990. The sun had set in Pointe - a - Pitre, a port in Gaudeloupe. Thousands had gathered on the docks to applaud a ship coming into the harbour. This was no ordinary vessel, but the winner of the Route du Rhum, a translatlantic solo race for men and women, started in 1978 and held every four years since. The solitary figure at the helm waved back at the crowd. For Florence Arthaud it had been a tiring 14 days 10 hours 8 minutes and 28 seconds with a happy end. She was the first woman to win the race and the first Gaudeloupean to claim the honour.
