INDIAN TRIBAL PAINTING

Of all branches of knowledge, the discipline of study of tribal painting successfully challenges chauvinism of class, race, culture and religion. Tribal painting – whether it is Warli of Maharashtra or Gond of Orissa and MP, or Toda (ritual painting on Pottery) of Nilgiri Hills of Tamilnadu – are intimately related to the rituals, life cycle ceremonies, belief, myth (that are different from Pan – Indian Mythology), social and world views of the tribes concerned. So Aesthetic appreciation of tribal pictorial tradition lead us to perceive yet another harmony that exists in India. Such studies also perpetuate the obliteration of artificial categorization of subjects of this nation into tribals and non-tribals.
