The credit goes to the One Woman Army of Mangalam Balasubramaniam. Mangalam with the active support of DANIDA (Danish International Development Association - a wing under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Denmark, engaged in developmental activities overseas) has for the past many years, been involved in environmental issues, rainwater harvesting, goshalas & entrepreneur development programmes for women & youth. Today Mangalam will talk about her Pammal project, her unique fund-collecting drives and the Self Help groups she has helped set up.

Sudha Murthy, Chairperson, Infosys Foundation, has put down her valuable life experiences about people in this first book she has written.


