
From the Membership Treasurer

Nirmala Seshadri: Then and Now -Personal and Artistic Reflections

Dancer Nirmala Seshadri presents "Then and Now - Personal and Artistic Reflections" an experiment in two parts. The first part is fragmented and deals with the memory of a traditional Bharatanatyam repertoire performed in the past, while the second segment is contemplative, a looking back and forward in the final chapter of a woman's life. The Miracle Cure of the 21st Century

Stem cells have been referred to as the miracle cure of the 21st century. Stem cells from the bone marrow have been used routinely in the treatment of a variety of non malignant & malignant conditions. Researchers have found that the blood collected from the umbilical cord is rich, safe and a non controversial source of stem cells. This largely untapped resource has until now been discarded at the time of birth. The talk by Dr. Saranya Nandakumar will help to increase the awareness of this new concept and will outline the necessity, importance and applications of banking the cord blood at the time of birth.
