South Indian Puppetry: An Illustrated Talk

Shadow puppet theatre of South India is a very vibrant tradition even today, although it has lost its audiences

M.D. Muthukumaraswamy holds a master's degree in English Language and Literature. With his work towards doctoral dissertation on "Semiotic analysis of Bharathakoothu: A study in theatrical communication", he taught in the post-graduate department of folklore, St. Xavier's College, Palayamkottai, Tamil Nadu ,from 1987 to 1996 and guided students He has been working as the Executive Trustee and Director of India's National Folklore Support Centre (NFSC), from its inception in the year 1997. National Folklore Support Centre has started functioning vigorously with a generous grant from the Ford Foundation from 1999 for advanced research. Mr.M.D.Muthukumaraswamy will discuss the artistry of the puppets, puppet making processes, performances, and their ritual contexts in relation to the changing patterns of patronage and sustenance for this art form. Illustrating the talk with field photographs and videos, W he will also bring into focus the defining characteristics of Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, and Malayalam puppets and their shared vocabularies and heritage.


